Next Gen Scholars Program

The Iowa Communications Alliance Next Gen Scholars program was created in response to our member companies need for skilled technicians. This program is available to students planning to pursue either the Network Technology - Telecommunications Certificate or the Network Technology - Telecom/Data Communications AAS Degree.

The process begins with recruitment, followed by an application and approval process. After the candidates are approved, the Iowa Communications Alliance, a sponsoring ICA member company, DMACC, and student split the tuition costs for the program. The sponsoring company may offer a mentoring program including paid or unpaid internship opportunities while the student attends DMACC. Successful completion of the DMACC program usually qualifies graduates



for an interview at the sponsoring company with a competitive salary and excellent advancement potential, though there is no guarantee of employment.

Next Gen Scholars Program Benefits

For the Students include:

- Apply real-world skills and experience to classroom instruction
- Receive support for education expenses
- Be considered for full-time employment

For the Sponsoring Company include:

- Access to motivated students who possess a wide range of skills and potential to complete a rigorous academic and experiential curriculum
- Opportunity to observe students' skills and work habits for a possible full-time job after graduation
- Improve the pipeline of skilled workers for employment

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must satisfy all of the following:

- Be a graduating high school senior.
- Be accepted by or be enrolled in an accredited two or four-year college/university or vocational school.
- Receive any qualifying service from an Iowa Communications Alliance service provider member and be from a rural area.
- Have a least a 3.5 on a 4.0 scale or 4.5 on a 5.0 scale for a cumulative grade point average.
- Express an interest to live and work in a rural community following graduation.
- Be sponsored by your local telecommunications service provider (contact your provider to determine if they
 are a member).
- Children of Iowa Communications Alliance member employees are not eligible for the general scholarship but are eligible for Member Employee Scholarship.

- Complete the scholarship application in full. If any information is incomplete, the application will not be considered.
- Prepare a 300-word essay:
 - Please share with the review committee why you are deserving of this scholarship and how the scholarship would impact your educational endeavors. Please also share how you plan to use your degree following the completion of your education.
- Include your most recent grade transcript with social security number masked out.
- Do not include any photographs with your application.
- The application deadline is March 4, 2021.
